

Official name: Beiqi Foton Motor Co Ltd.

Owned by: BAIC Group (Beijing Automotive Industry Holding Co Ltd). BAIC is owned by the Chinese government.

Current situation: Founded in 1996, Foton mainly builds trucks, buses and agricultural machinery. It also has a tiny range of SUVs and pickups. Reputedly China's biggest truckmaker, Foton has a partnership with the Daimler group and others. Foton boasts 29,000 employees and a rank of number four in the Chinese auto industry, but it is unclear if these figures are solely for Foton or for Foton and Beijing Automotive combined. While Foton has a strong presence in China, it's global ambitions have thusfar come to little. Foton pickups and trucks are barely a blip on the radar internationally and Foton's operations in India have been a disaster.
